

Background

Patricia Campbell has been involved in some aspect of dance since the age of 5. She became a caller in the summer of 1986. Her repertoire of "Traditional Country Dancing" includes contra-style dance, traditional square dance, 18th century (Colonial) dance, International Folk Dance, and "Singing Games" which are also known as "PlayParty" Games - dances that are done to songs rather than to music by instruments. She leads workshops and residencies, along with family and community dances and Colonial Balls.

She performed and was a Board member and on the Programming Committee for the NOMAD (Northeast Music, Art and Dance) Festival for most of its 20-year run. Traditional dance includes a variety of names and types of social dance: barn dance, ceilidh, community dance, square dance, English country dance, International Folk Dance, just to name a sample. It is an engaging and lively social activity, which Patricia leads most frequently with live music provided by The Reel Thing and other bands. In an age of increasing isolation and solitary activities, traditional dance continues to bring people together the way it has done for generations.

Patricia has led dance programs for homeschoolers' groups, libraries, schools, senior centers, community organizations, monthly family dances, and many community "Barn Dances" (a little of everything), as well as historical dances and balls for re-enactors. Her current focus is on community, school, and family dances as well as the historical dances for anyone interesting in creating a Colonial Ball or other historical dance event.
